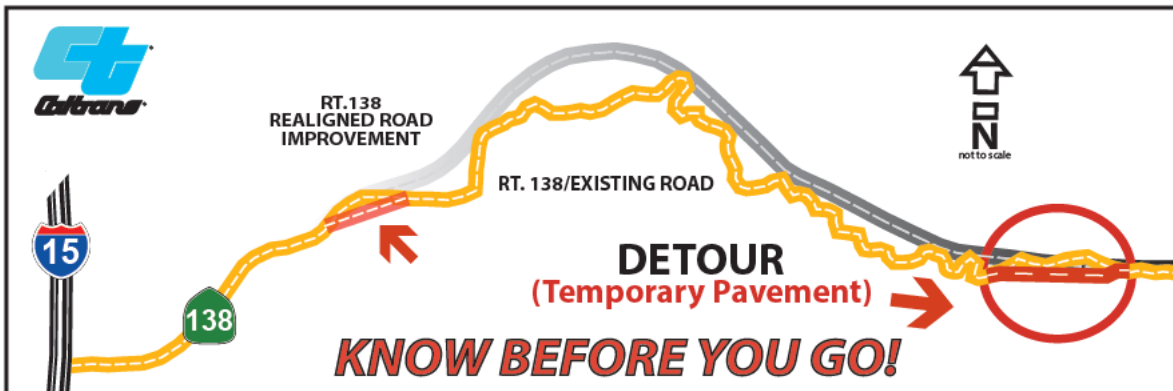

## STATE ROUTE 138 (EAST) REALIGNMENT PROJECT RE-OPENS TO TRAFFIC

**SAN BERNARDINO** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$23 million State Route 138 (SR-138) East Realignment Project. The project is located on SR-138 just east of Interstate 15 to Summit Post Office Road. The realignment will remove several curves and steep grades reducing the three-mile stretch by one mile. The project also includes constructing outside shoulders, three bridges, and three wildlife crossings. SR-138 will remain a two-lane road with one lane in each direction.

SR-138 east of Interstate 15 is open to traffic after being closed for one day. The existing road opens to traffic on Friday, June 9, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. The full closure was necessary to complete a temporary detour and earthwork in preparation for the new realignment of SR-138. Please note the new temporary alignment towards the far east end of the project (see map below).

Please be mindful that this is an active construction zone and **BE WORK ZONE ALERT!**
