NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO REVIEW AND ADOPT
THE FISCAL YEARS 2019/20 & 2020/21 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN**

The Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) is a planning document used by the City to identify capital improvement needs and to coordinate funding and timing of those needs based on City Council's direction and anticipated funding availability. The CIP includes projects that have been identified as funded, and partially funded for Fiscal Years (FYs) 2019/20 & 2020/21 as well as projects anticipated through the build-out of the City.

The FYs 2019/20 & 2020/21 Proposed CIP identifies the costs of constructing the following types of projects anticipated through build-out of the City:

- Streets and Highways
- Bridges
- Buildings
- Drainage
- Electric Utility
- Landscaping
- Parks
- Traffic Signals
- Underground Utilities
- Other

California Government Code Section 66002 provides that any local agency which levies a Development Impact Fee subject to California Government Code Section 66001 may adopt a Capital Improvement Plan, which shall indicate the approximate location, size, time of availability, and estimates of cost for these facilities or improvements to be funded with the fees.

A Public Hearing will be held on **Tuesday, June 4, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.** to review and approve projects to be incorporated into the FYs 2019/20 & 2020/21 Capital Improvement Plan. The meeting will take place at:
