**2009 - MAXIMUM STATE RENTS BY UNIT SIZE AND INCOME LIMIT RESTRICTIONS
EFFECTIVE APRIL 2009**

For the purpose of determining State (HCD) Affordable Rents, 25 California Code of Regulations §6918, defines Affordable Rent as the monthly rent plus utility allowance. **The monthly rent plus utility allowance cannot exceed the amounts indicated below for the appropriate number of bedrooms.**

1) MAXIMUM RENTS IF UTILITIES ARE PAID BY THE PROPERTY OWNER: If the property owner pays the utilities, the maximum allowable State (RDA) rents (including the owner paid utilities) may not exceed the amount indicated below for the appropriate number of bedrooms; or

2) MAXIMUM RENTS IF UTILITIES ARE PAID BY THE TENANT(S): If the some or all of the utilities are paid by the tenant(s), the maximum allowable State (RDA) rents plus utilities based on the "Utility Allowance Schedule" cannot exceed the amounts indicated below for the appropriate number of bedrooms.
