A guideline would be: DIFFICULT/STRENUOUS (significant elevation gains/challenging terrain); and MODERATE (some elevation gains/hills).

Hike to Lake Perris (DIFFICULT)

(Approximately 7.2 miles round trip)

### September 29, 2018

Hike to Hidden Springs (MODERATE)
Meet at 7:30 a.m. in the parking lot directly in front of
Hidden Springs Elementary School

(Approximately 3.3 miles round trip)

Hike to Box Springs M Trail (DIFFICULT)
Meet at 7:30 a.m. in the parking lot on the west side of campus
Canyon Springs High School

(Approximately 4.8 miles round trip)
