



Inkless Ink Crime Deterrent Program

Identity theft and fraud is a growing problem in America and around the world. Once thieves have your personal information, it can be used in a variety of ways: Credit card fraud, bank / finance fraud and government documents.

Lower your risk by participating in the Inkless Ink Crime Deterrent Program. The program is designed to deter counterfeit and stolen check fraud by obtaining a thumbprint from the customer.

The thumbprint can be used by law enforcement agencies in the investigation of fraud claims made by merchants, and financial institutions. The thumbprint will be shared with law enforcement agencies only in cases of suspected fraud.

How the Program Works



The customer will place their right thumb in the ink pad and place the thumbprint on the face of the check between the memo and signature line. Once completed the customer simply rubs the index finger and thumb together removing any remaining ink. The process is widely accepted by consumers, who reportedly appreciate the extra security, provided by merchants.
