



Moreno Valley Utility Quarterly Report of Power Content

The State of California passed legislation in the form of Senate Bill 1305, which requires load serving Electric Utilities to provide customers with a copy of a Power Content Label on a quarterly basis. This label breaks down the type of energy resources that are used to serve the Utility's electric customers. The CA Power Mix represents the breakdown for Utilities that are not making specific claims regarding power purchases. On the right is the Power Content Label, as provided by the California Energy Commission.
